Plane

Newquay Airport is just 25 minutes by car.

You can fly to Newquay from London Gatwick, Manchester, Edinburgh, Glasgow, Belfast and Norwich. Car rental at Newquay Airport and Truro Station: Hertz, Europcar.

Car

From London to Bristol: take the M4 to junction 20 and then join the M5 motorway signposted South West, Bristol (west) airport.

From Bristol to Exeter: take the M5 to junction 31.

From Exeter: leave M5 at junction 31, merge onto A30. Continue on the A30 for about an hour until you hit the Carland Cross roundabout which signposts you to Truro on the first exit (A39). Follow the road through the next roundabout to Truro, first exit, and at the end of the road, turn right onto Tregolls road.

After 0.3miles, at the roundabout, take the 3rd exit onto Morlaix Ave/A39 and shortly after, you'll hit a second roundabout where you take the 3rd exit onto Fairmantle St (passing a large car park on your right).

At the end of the road you will meet Lemon Street and find Bustophers directly ahead of you. There is short term parking all along the street or 3 pay and display car parks within a 2 minute walk.
